- Premco Global Ltd. has paid Rs 39 per share as special dividend in the year FY25
- **Vedanta** has paid 4 interim dividend in FY25 amounting to Rs 43.5 per share and 5 interim dividend in FY23 amounting to Rs 101.5 per share. For FY24, it paid 2 interim dividend of Rs 18.5 and Rs 11.0 per share.
- **Hindustan Zinc Ltd.** has paid 4 interim dividend in FY23 amounting Rs 75.5 per share unlike 2 interim dividend and 3 interim dividend amounting to Rs 13 per share and Rs 29 per share for FY24 and FY25 respectively.
- D-Link India has paid Rs 5 per share as a special dividend along with Rs 15 per share as final dividend for FY25.
- Castrol India has paid special dividend of Rs 4.5 per share for CY24.
- UTI AMC has paid Rs 23 and Rs 22 per share as special dividend in FY24 and FY25 respectively.
- Stovec Industries Ltd has paid a special dividend of Rs 157 per share in CY23.
- D.B. Corp Ltd. has paid 3 interim dividend in FY24 unlike 2 in FY23.
- Vardhman Acrylics Ltd has paid Rs 25 per share as interim dividend for FY22.
- **Bhansali Engineering Polymers'** dividend for FY25 and FY24 is adjusted for bonus issued in FY24 in the ratio of 1:2. Also, the dividend for FY23 includes special dividend of Rs 14 per share (adjusted at Rs 9.33 per share against bonus).
